

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS –**  
**NETTLEFOLD PLACE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate Thames Water maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Nettlefold Place which lies between its junction with Knight's Hill and the western property boundary of No. 24-26 Knight's Hill.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via:

- a) Knight's Hill, Norwood Road, York Hill, Royal Circus, Pymont Grove, Canterbury Grove, Thurlestone Road, Dodbrooke Road, Hainthorpe Road, Wolfington Road and Casewick Road, and
- (b) Casewick Road, Thornlaw Road and Knight's Hill.

3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies, the one-way system in Nettlefold Place would be temporarily suspended to allow access to and egress from that length of road.

4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order would come into force on 18th October 2023 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 18th October 2023 and 19th October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
