ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – ROTHSCHILD STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate carriageway repairs on Knights Hill and Thornlaw Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with agreement from London Buses have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend parking on both sides of the entire length of Rothschild Street to enable buses on diversion and other traffic to navigate the diversion route on Rothschild Street.

2. Alternative routes for northbound affected vehicles on Knights Hill will be available via (a) Knights Hill, Rothschild Street, Norwood High Street, Ernest Avenue and Knights Hill. (b) Southbound traffic on Knights Hill is unaffected by the planned works.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 10th September 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 10th September 2023 and 11th September 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
