### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – STONHOUSE STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable mobile crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of Stonhouse Street, which lies between the north-western boundary of No. 162 Stonhouse Street and the north-western kerbline of Clapham High Street; and
- (b) ban pedestrians from entering the south-western footway, between the northwestern boundary of No. 162 Stonhouse Street and the north-western kerbline of Clapham High Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be provided via Clapham High Street, Clapham Manor Street and Cresset Street, and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 26th September 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be completed on the 26th September 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
