ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (WANDSWORTH) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2008 A3205 GLA SIDE ROAD (GARTONS WAY) VARIATION ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that on 5th September it made the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 11th September 2023.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order is to remove the 10 metres Parking and Disabled Persons' Vehicles bay on Gartons Way, on the side of No.200 York Road and introduce double red line restrictions, operating 'No Stopping at Any Time'.
3. The roads which would be affected by the Order are the A3205 GLA Side Road – Gartons Way in the London Borough of Wandsworth.
4. A copy of the Orders, a statement of Transport for London's reasons for the proposals, a map indicating the location and effect of the Orders and copies of any Order revoked, suspended or varied by the Orders can be inspected by appointment during normal office hours at our office at the address below. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
