ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - MEPHAM STREET & TENISON STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate public realm improvements, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Mepham Street which lies between York Road (A3200) and Tenison Way.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available for buses via (a) York Road (A3200), Westminster Bridge Road (A302), Baylis Road (B300), and Waterloo Road; business loading only will be available (b) in a north-westerly direction via Waterloo Road, Mepham Street, Tenison Way, Waterloo Road and (c) in a south-easterly direction via Mepham Street and Waterloo Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order comes into force on 23rd October 2023 and continues for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 23rd October 2023 and 9th December 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
