

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Supply of Alcohol, Mon: 07:00-18:00/ Tue-Sun: 07:00-23:00, Live Music, Tue-Sun: 07:00-22:00, Recorded Music, Mon: 07:00-18:00/ Tue-Sun: 07:00-23:00, Shop Opening Times, Mon: 07:00-18:00/ Tue-Sun: 07:00-23:00.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than 10/11/2023.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
