

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING**  
**RESTRICTIONS – NORFOLK HOUSE ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS GIVEN that, to facilitate the replacement of a telecom pole, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Norfolk House Road between the junctions of Brancaster Road and Blakemore Road.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Brancaster Road, Mount Ephraim Road, and Blakemore Road and (b) Norfolk House Road, Streatham High Road, Mount Ephraim Road, and Brancaster Road.
3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order comes into force on 27 March 2024 and continues for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place for one day on 27 March 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 1 month.
