

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Lewisham (Off Street) (Parking Places) (Amendment No 1) Order 2024

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 14th March 2024 made the above-mentioned Order under the powers the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into force on 18th March 2024:-

2. The effect of these proposals is as follows:

PTO 1026 The effect of the above orders will be to

- a) introduce the requirement for motor cyclists to pay for parking in following Lewisham Off-Street car parks
Beckenham Place Car Park; Blackheath Grove Car Park; Canadian Avenue Car Park; Clarendon Rise Car Park; Girton Road Car Park; Holbeach Road Car Park (Ground Floor); Molesworth Street Car Park; Pearcefield Avenue Car Park; Pearcefield Avenue Car Park; Perry Vale Car Park; Slaithwaite Road Car Park; Thomas Lane Car Park; Vanguard Street Car Park.

The charge for a motorcycle left in a car park shall be:

- i) £0.20 for a maximum parking period of 15 minutes;
- ii) £0.80 for a maximum parking period of 1 hour; and
- iii) £2.00 for a maximum parking period of one day.

3. A pack of documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order can be collected for inspection between 9am – 5pm Mondays to Fridays at the office of the London Borough of Lewisham, Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU. 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
