ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 GLA SIDE ROAD (GOODWOOD CLOSE, LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas mains replacement works to take place on Goodwood Close.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Goodwood Close between a point 6 metres north-west of the extended north-western building line of Nos. 202 to 204 London Road and its junction with A24 London Road.

The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on 15th April 2024 until 7:00 PM on 20th May 2024, or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
