

London Borough of Lewisham SCHOOL STREETS

The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (School Streets) (No.2) Traffic Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham on 27 September 2024 made the above Traffic Regulation Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended). The Order will come into force on 30 September 2024.

- The general effect of the Order will be to make permanent the following experimental measures as imposed by “The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (School Streets) (No. 14) Experimental Traffic Order 2023”:- (a) introduce new ‘pedestrian and cycle zones’ to restrict vehicle access in the vicinity of, comprising the roads or parts of roads listed in column (2) of Schedule 1 to this Notice. These pedestrian and cycle zones will operate at the times listed in column (3) of Schedule 1 and with permits identified in column (1) and (4) to this Notice; and (b) prohibit vehicles proceeding in a road or length of road in column (1) from entering the road or length of road specified in column (2) of Schedule 2, except pedal cycles using a pedal cycle gap.
- All motor vehicles except exempt vehicles will be restricted from entering each pedestrian and cycle zone during their hours of operation. Any vehicle that is already within a pedestrian and cycle zone prior to its commencement of operation will be permitted to leave.

- If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
