ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A302 GLA ROAD (WESTMINSTER BRIDGE ROAD, WESTMINSTER BRIDGE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER AND THE LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge expansion joint
- replacement works to take place at the A302 Westminster Bridge. 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,
- exiting, proceeding or stopping on Westminster Bridge and Westminster Bridge Road between its junctions Lambeth Palace Road and Victoria Embankment.

The Order will be effective between the 14th October 2024 and the 18th October 2024 every night from 8.00 PM and 6.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Lambeth Palace Road. Lambeth Bridge. Millbank, Abingdon Street, Parliament Square and Bridge Street or the reverse to normal route of travel.
