ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (SOUTHWARK STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable drainage works to take place at A3200 GLA Side Road – Stoney Street.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:

- (1) entering or exiting Stoney Street at its junction with Southwark Street;
- (2) stopping on Southwark Street between its junctions with Redcross Way and Borough High Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 7.00 AM on the 23rd September 2024 until 11.59 PM on the 22nd April 2025 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. The Order will also permit motor vehicles to access Stoney Street at its junction with Park Street.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Borough High Street, Bedale Street, Cathedral Street, Winchester Walk and Stoney Street to normal route of travel.
