Application for a Premises Licence

An application has been made by Mason & Fifth TIB Ltd for a premises licence for Basement area, Italian Building, 41 Dockhead, London SE1 2BS. The application provides for the supply of alcohol to residents and their bona fide guests from noon to 23.00 every day.

It is an offence under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 for anyone to recklessly or knowingly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application. The maximum fine on conviction is unlimited.
