

New Premises Licence Application Licensing Act 2003

An application has been made by Apple Europe Limited to Wandsworth Council for a new Premises Licence for premises to be known as Apple Radio Studios, Levels 2 to 4, Battersea Power Station, Circus Rd W, Nine Elms, London SW11 8AL.

The premises will be used as a content studio with restricted access for the general public. The application provides for the sale and supply of alcohol and the provision of regulated entertainment (films, plays, dance, indoor sports events, live music and recorded music) between 10am (9am for recorded music) and 11.30pm Mondays to Wednesdays, 10am (9am for recorded music) to 12.30am on the day following on Thursdays to Saturdays and 10am (9am for recorded music) and 11pm on Sundays and late night refreshment between 11pm and 11.30pm on Mondays to Wednesdays and 11pm and 12.30am on the day following on Thursdays to Saturdays together with non-standard timings and subject to proposed conditions.
