### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER SECTION 17

To permit live music on Mondays to Tuesdays from 11.00 to 23.00, Wednesdays 11.00 to 01.00, Thursdays to Saturdays 11.00 to 02.00 and on Sundays 11.00 to 24.00. 5. To permit recorded music on Sundays to Tuesdays 11.00 to 24.00, Wednesdays from 11.00 to 01.00 and on Thursdays to Saturdays 11.00 to 02.00. Please Note, these hours are identical to those on the lapsed licence. Any representations by a responsible authority or any other person regarding this application must be received in writing by:- the Licensing Authority, The Town Hall, Hornton Street, London, W8 7NX no later than the 21st November 2024 stating the grounds for representations.
