

Notice of application to vary a Premises Licence under

Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003

Notice is hereby given that Young & Co's Brewery Plc in respect of Premises known as Hope & Anchor, 123 Acre Lane, Brixton, London, SW2 5UA applied to Lambeth Council for a Variation of a Premises Licence. The proposed variation is: 1. To vary the layout of the premises for the ground and first floors only (all other floors to remain as existing) in accordance with plans supplied by the applicant – see application for full details. 2. To remove condition 32 under Annex 2 which reads “That the garden be closed at 11pm 7 days a week, as condition 20 under Annex 2 limits the use of the garden – see application for full details. All licensable activities, permitted hours, opening hours and conditions to remain as existing. Any representations regarding the above-mentioned application must be received in writing by Licensing Section, Lambeth Council, 3rd Floor Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London, SW2 1EG or by e-mail licensing@lambeth.gov.uk no later than 26th February 2025 stating the grounds for representation. The register of Lambeth Council and the record of the application may be inspected at the address of the council, given above, during normal business hours or if it is available on the council's website at - www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application. A person is liable to an unlimited fine on conviction should such a false statement be made.
