

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is hereby given that Sloane Square Hotel Ltd has applied to the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea for the VARIATION of a premises licence to: Remove conditions 9 ((e)-(f)), 12 & 29 & amend condition 13. Include a condition to not permit the premises to be used as a nightclub under its current licence (912910). Remove Exhibition of films (Bsmt Bar only), Performance of dance, Entertainment similar to music or dance (Bsmt Bar & Gmd floor restaurant only), Performance of live music (Gmd floor restaurant only), Playing of recorded music (Gmd floor reception and Lobby Area only). Vary the basement plans for the premises Sloane Square Hotel situated at 7-12 Sloane Square, SW1W.

Any person wishing to submit representations to my/our application must give notice in writing to Licensing Authority address shown above, giving in detail the grounds of objection by 18/03/25.

The Council will not entertain representations where the writer requests that his identity remains anonymous. Copies of all representations will be included in the papers presented to the Licensing Sub-Committee and will therefore pass into the public domain. Representations must relate to one of the four Licensing Objectives: the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm. In the case of an application for a provisional statement, please note that representations will be restricted once a statement has been issued.

It is an offence liable on conviction to a fine under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with this application.
