## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE A23 GLA ROAD (LONDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2025

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bus shelter installation works to take place on the A23 London Road.
- to take place on the A23 London Road.

  3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - stopping on London Road between its junction with St Helen's Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 1449 and 1451 London Road;

The Order will also:

- (2) permit all vehicles to use the northbound bus lane on London Road between its junctions with St Helen's Road and Fairview Road.
- The Order will be effective between 8:00 PM on 3rd March 2025 until 5:00 AM on 5th March 2025, or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
