

MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009

APPLICATION FOR RIVERBANK HOUSE

Notice is hereby given that Trina DeSilva from The City of London Corporation has applied to the Marine Management Organisation under the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, Part 4, for a marine licence to undertake the following:

Scour protection works in front of the existing flood defence wall at Oystergate Walk. The works involve removing/cutting down the existing camp shed timbers and redundant gabion baskets. The foreshore will then be reinstated in front of the flood defence river wall to its original level using a sloped revetment formed from imported granular fill using aqua rock bags and rock mattresses.
